# Knitted Daffodils

This daffodil pattern is knitted in two parts – trumpet and petals. Never make the petals a darker shade than the trumpet or your daffodil will look very strange.

## Petals

Cast on 3 stitches in yellow.

I-cord 6 rows and then separate stitches out onto three needles and continue working in the round.

1. **Round 1:** kfb x 3 (6)
2. **Round 2:** [kfb, k1] x 3 (9)
3. **Round 3:** kfb x 9 (18)
4. **Round 4:** kfb x 18 (36)

Switch to working in the flat for the first of the petals as follows:

## PETAL

1. **Row 1:** k1, kfb x 3, k2 (9)
2. **Row 2:** [p1, k1] x 4, p1
3. **Row 3:** kfb x 8, k1 (17)
4. **Row 4:** [p1, k1] x 8, p1
5. **Row 5:** [k1, p1] x 8, k1
6. **Row 6:** [p1, k1] x 8, p1
7. **Row 7:** [k1, p1] x 8, k1
8. **Row 8:** [p1, k1] x 8, p1
9. **Row 9:** k1, k2tog x 2, [p1, k1] x 4, k2tog x 2
10. **Row 10:** [p1, k1] x 6, p1 (13)
11. **Row 11:** k1, k2tog x 2, [p1, k1] x 2, k2tog x 2
12. **Row 12:** [p1, k1] x 4, p1 (9)
13. **Row 13:** k1, k2tog x 4 (5)
14. **Row 14:** p1, p2tog x 2 (3)



Thread yarn through remaining sts and pull tight.

Work the pattern for PETAL six times, so that no stitches remain. Rejoin the yarn to the live stitches after each petal is completed.

## Trumpet

Cast on 9sts in orange and join into the round.

1. **Round 1:** k –
2. **Round 2:** kfb x 9
3. **Rounds 3 to 12:** [k1, p1] x 9
4. **Round 13:** p –

Repeat the following bullet points until no stitches remain.

- cast on 1st
- cast off 2sts
- If your cast off method leaves a stitch on the RH-needle, transfer it back to the LH-needle.

Turn the finished trumpet inside out.

# Crochet Daffodil



## Magic Loop

Start with a magic loop 0 using 6 double crochet.

Make a loop with yarn, leaving a tail around 10cm long. Insert hook into loop, from front to back. Wrap the working yarn around the hook anticlockwise and pull the yarn through the magic loop.

Make a turning chain of one chain, and work stitches into the magic loop - all the stitches need to be worked over both the loop and the tail (so over two strands of yarn). Once you've worked the number of stitches need, pull up the tail end of the yarn to draw up the ring. Close round with a slip stitch as usual.

**Round 2** 2dc into each st around. [12 sts]

**Round 3** (2dc into next st, 1 dc into next st) 6 times. [18 sts]

**Round 4** (Ch8, ss into second ch from hook, 1dc into next ch, 1htr into next ch, 1tr into each of the next 2 ch, 1dtr into next ch, 1tr in final ch, skip next dc, ss into back loop only of each of next 2 dc) 6 times. [6 petals]

**Round 5** \*Working up the opposite side of the ch of the petal, work (1tr, 1dtr, 1tr into each of next 2 ch, 1htr, 1dc, ss in next ch, picot), ss into each of next 7 sts down the other side, skip 1 ss, 1dc into next ss. Repeat from \* five times more.

**Fasten off.**

## Centre of daffodil

**Round 1** (RS) Rejoin Yarn B in front loop only of any dc in Round 3, ch1 (does not count as dc), 1dc into each dc around. [18 sts]

**Rounds 2-4** 1dc into each st around.

**Round 5** (Picot, ss into st at base of ch and next 2 sts) 6 times.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

## Finishing

Block daffodil to shape.

# Shirley's Easy Knitted Flower

(Could use used for poppies if red/black or for other flowers if using different colours.)

Red DK & Black DK

Cast on 60 sts **Red**, 8,9 or 10 size needles  
(3.5-4mm)

**Knit** 3 rows

**Purl** 3 rows

**Knit** 3 rows

Change to black

K2tog to end (30sts)

K2tog to end (15sts)

K2tog to end (8sts)

K2tog to end (4sts)

Draw wool through & sew up with black.

Sew red edges.

# Lorraine's Easy Crochet Flower

Colour A - main flower petals

Colour B - scraps for center of flower

Colour C - scraps for stamens

Using Colour A - make a slip ring.

**Round 1:** Ch3, 9 treble crochet into ring. Pull the slip ring tight to close centre of ring and slip stitch in top ch to join.

**Round 2:** 3ch, 4trtr in same stitch. In next stitch 5 trtr. \*In next stitch 1 tr and 4 trtr, in next stitch 5 trtr. REPEAT from \* to end of round, ending with slip st in top to join. Fasten off. Sew in eneds.

Centre:

Using colour B, make slip ring ch3. 9 trebel crochet into ring and slip stitch in top ch to join. Pull tail end to close centre of ring. Fasten off leaving long tail to attach centre to body of poppy.

Finishing:

Using Colour C - Cut short lengths of yarn and using a small hook, attach them like a fringe to the post of each stitch in round 1. Stitch centre to body of flower.

(Notes, the petals are made up of 5 groups of 10 stitches worked over 2 trebles of the first round.)



# Crochet Easter Egg



Any size hook & yarn

ch 8

**Row 1:** 2 sc in second ch from hook, 1 sc in next 5 ch, 2 sc in last ch (9 sc)

**Row 2:** ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first stitch, 1 sc in next 7, 2 sc in last stitch (11 sc)

**Row 3:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (11 sc)

**Row 4:** ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first stitch, 1 sc in next 9, 2 sc in last stitch (13 sc)

**Row 5:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (13 sc)

**Row 6:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (13 sc)

**Row 7:** ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first stitch, 1 sc in next 11, 2 sc in last stitch (15 sc)

**Row 8:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (15 sc)

**Row 9:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (15 sc)

**Row 10:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (15 sc)

**Row 11:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (15 sc)

**Row 12:** ch 1, turn, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 11 stitches, sc2tog (13 sc)

**Row 13:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (13 sc)

**Row 14:** ch 1, turn, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 9 stitches, sc2tog (11 sc)

**Row 15:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (11 sc)

**Row 16:** ch 1, turn, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 7 stitches, sc2tog (9 sc)

**Row 17:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (9 sc)

**Row 18:** ch 1, turn, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 5 stitches, sc2tog (7 sc)

**Row 19:** ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each stitch (7 sc)

**Row 20:** ch 1, turn, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 3 stitches, sc2tog (5 sc)

**Row 21:** ch 1, turn, sc2tog, 1 sc in next stitch, sc2tog (3 sc)

To finish continue by crocheting all the way around the outside edge, then finish off, cut yarn and weave in ends.

## Granny Square Crochet Easter Egg

Make a magic loop (like the daffodil) and make 9 double crochet inside the ring.

Join to 1st stitch with a slip stitch.

**Round 1:** Chain 3. 1 tr in the first stitch. (This makes the first group of 2 stitches). [ch1, 2tr in next stitch] 8 times. Ch1. Join with slip stitch to top of ch3. There are 9 chain 1 spaces.

**Round 2:** Slip Stitch in next tr to position hook at first chain 1 space. Ch3, 2tr in 1st chain 1 space. Chain 1. [3tr, ch1] in next 3 spaces. 3Trtr in next space. Chain 1. [3tr, ch1] in the remaining 4 spaces. Ch1. Join with slip st in the top of ch3. Tie off and weave in ends.

# Easy Knitted Easter Egg

Any size needles & yarn, using garter stitch.

Cast on 6 sts.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: K2, M1L, K to last two sts, M1L, K2 (8 sts)

Rows 3 – 9: Repeat Row 2 ( 22 sts)

Row 10 – 15: Knit

Row 16: K1, K2tog, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1 (20 sts)

Rows 17 – 23: Repeat Row 16 ( 6 sts)

Bind off, cut yarn, secure last stitch, and weave the ends in.

(If you want to make bigger eggs, use more stitches and increase the number of rows in the middle.)

# Crochet Cross

**Row 1:** Ch 8, sl st in first chain to form a ring. Ch 3 (counts as a dc), (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in the ring, dc, Turn

**Rows 2-14:** \*Ch 3 (Counts as a dc), (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in the ch 2 space) Shell made in the previous ch 2 from row 1. dc in the top of the Ch 3, Turn, \*Repeat Row 2, for a total of 14 Shells. Fasten off after row 14.

The Arms of the Cross: Make 2 Arms

**Row 1:** Sl st into the side of the row 6, sl st on top of the dc, Ch 3 (Counts as a dc) work 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in the chain 3 space, dc in the ch 3, (Shell Made) Turn

**Rows 2-4:** \*Ch 3 on top of the dc, work 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in the chain 3 space, dc in the ch 3, Turn, Shell Made, Repeat Row 2, two more times. For a total of 4 shells for the arms. Repeat Rows 1-4 on the opposite side for the other arm.

**Edge:** Sl st in the beginning chain 8, In the Chain 8, work 2 sc, ch 2, 2 sc in each chain 2 and chain 3 spaces, and sc in each dc around, sl st. Fasten off and Weave in the ends.
